An excellent disposition for teamwork and good knowledge in English are prerequisites. Doctoral dissertation on a relevant topic, good publishing record and experience in conducting analysis on the field of research are considered as major assets in the selection process. A particular regional focus- Russian Arctic and Arctic Security policy will be appreciated.
